

Terms and conditions of the “Time Measuring Application for Sport Competitions”

Competition by Totalizator Sportowy

- 1.** These terms and conditions (hereinafter referred to as Terms) stipulate the rules and conditions of the “Time Measuring Application for Sport Competitions” Competition in a hackathon event HackYeah and is an annex to the general terms and conditions of HackYeah Hackathon.
- 2.** The Hackathon Sponsor and promising prize within the meaning of art. 921 § 3 of the Civil Code (Journal of Laws 2017, item 459) is Totalizator Sportowy Sp. z o.o., with registered office in Warszawa 03-728, Ul. Targowa 25, registered under following numbers: NIP (Taxpayers ID no): 525-00-10-982 and REGON (Business ID no): 01286274900000, entered into KRS (National Court Register) under number 0000007411, which may be reached at centrala@totalizator.pl e-mail address.
- 3.** Details of the task will be presented at the start of the competition.
- 4.** Participation in the "Time Measuring Application for Sport Competitions" competition may be taken individually and in teams of up to six people who have started solving the competition task no earlier than 6:00 pm on November 27th and forwarded the task for evaluation no later than 10:00 a.m. on November 29th. The task submitted for evaluation should include: project title, team ID, project description, snapshots, PDF presentation, demo link. The task solutions should be submitted to platform ChallengeRocket.
- 5.** Participants related or affined to the second degree with members of the “Time Measuring Application for Sport Competitions” Jury are excluded from participation.
- 6.** The Competition is to present the solutions to the problem enclosed in <https://hackyeah.pl/task-time-measuring-application-for-sport-competitions/> . The solutions of respective tasks will be evaluated by a Jury assigned to a respective task, consisting of at least two members. The prize in the competition is 25 000 PLN.
- 7.** Jury and Jury members’ decisions are final and cannot be appealed.
- 8.** Any alterations or revisions made after the statutory time is expired are illegal. Any alterations and revisions made after the statutory time is expired will not be considered by the Jury.
- 9.** At the moment of announcement of the Contest winner, the author/authors of the work that won the contest shall transfer to Totalizator Sportowy shall acquire the ownership of the entire rights to the work that won the contest, including all author’s economic rights to such work, including also the right to permit the exercise of derivative copyright to such work, on all fields of exploitation as stipulated in the Polish Law of 4 February 1994 on

Copyright And Related Rights (hereinafter the “Polish Copyright Act”) existing at the moment of the transfer of the abovementioned copyrights, including the fields of exploitation as set in Article 50 and 74.4 of the Polish Copyright Act and in particular:

- a) within the scope of fixing and reproduction of works - production of copies of a work with the use of specific technology, including printing, reprographics, magnetic fixing and digital technology;
- b) within the scope of trading the original or the copies on which the work was fixed - introduction to trade, lending for use or rental of the original or copies;
- c) within the scope of dissemination of works in a manner different from defined in subparagraph 2 - public performance, exhibition, screening, presentation and broadcasting as well as retransmission, and making the work publicly available in such a manner that anyone could access it at a place and time selected thereby.
- d) the permanent or temporary reproduction of a computer programs in full or in part, by any means and in any form; where it is necessary to reproduce a computer program for its loading, displaying, running, transmitting and storing, consent of the winner of the contest shall not be required for such acts;
- e) the translation, adaptation, arrangement or any other alteration of a computer program, providing for the rights of the person who made such alterations;
- f) the public dissemination, including lending for use or rental, of a computer program or a copy thereof.

10. Development of the solution that will be required in order to implement it in sponsor’s environment may be a subject of further arrangements between the sponsor and the winner
